

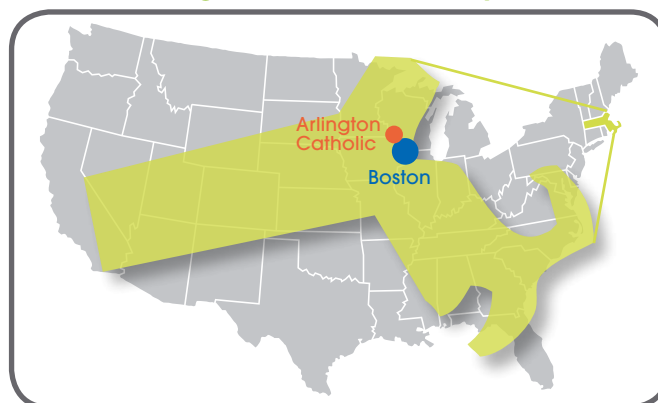
Private Day School
