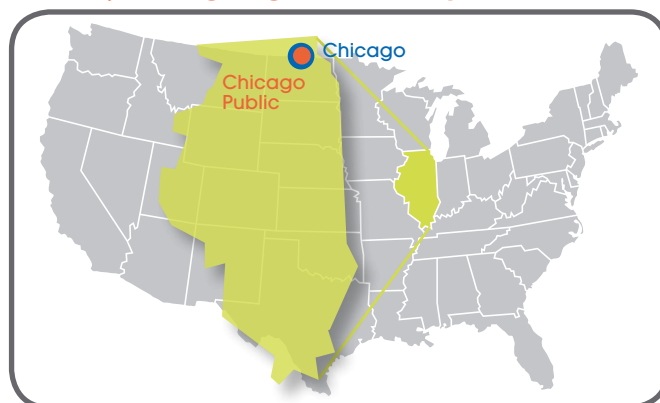
### School Profile
