

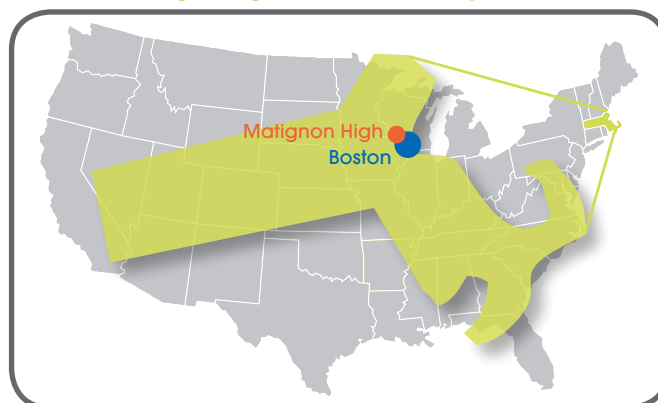
## Private Day School
